1. Purpose. To approve disestablishment of subject shore activity and detachment per reference (a).
2. Background. This is an administrative organization correction action. The command and detachment concerned were slated for disestablishment under a 2006 Naval Meteorology and Oceanography Command reorganization and were, in fact, effectively disestablished in 2006 with the removal of all personnel. This notice officially disestablishes the command and detachment, removes them from the Standard Navy Distribution List and directs Defense Finance and Accounting Service to remove the Unit Identification Codes (UICs) from the active UIC database.

4. Action

a. Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command will take appropriate action to disestablish subject shore command and detachment.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete the PLA in the Central Directory Component effective immediately unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. NAVNETWARCOM will coordinate removal of the PLA in the Defense Messaging Service system with applicable Navy Computer and Telecommunications Area Master Station.

c. Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33), will revise reference (b).

5. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
