Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF NAVAL RESERVE OFFICERS TRAINING CORPS UNIT (NROTCU) CONSORTIUM AT COLLEGE OF THE HOLY CROSS AND YALE UNIVERSITY AND MODIFICATION OF EXISTING NROTCU NAME TO REFLECT NEW STRUCTURE

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval to establish subject shore activity consortium per reference (a).

2. Background. Establishment of the new NROTCU consortium is being undertaken in order to increase the number of NROTCUs at the nation's elite schools. The Chief of Naval Personnel will provide funding support for the increase of unit staff as appropriate at both institutions, with the consortium having one commanding officer.

3. Organizational Changes. Establish subject consortium through modification of existing NROTCU College of the Holy Cross effective immediately. The following applies:

4. Action


a. Commander, Naval Education and Training Command will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to modify subject shore activity and to issue a revised mission, functions, and task directive for the new shore activity consortium within 90 days of such establishment. Distribution of this directive will include Director, Navy Staff (DNS-33).

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will revise the PLA in the Central Directory Component effective immediately unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. Correspondence concerning the PLA should be forwarded to Naval Network Warfare Command (NAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), Bldg 1265, Joint Expeditionary Base, Virginia Beach, VA 23459-5000 or by calling (757) 322-1149/1150.
