Subj: TRANSPORTATION AND TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

Ref: (a) DoD Directive 4500.09E of 11 Sep 07

1. Purpose. To implement the Department of Defense (DoD) transportation and traffic management policies within the Navy.

2. Cancellation. OPNAVINST 4610.8F.

3. Background. Reference (a) has been revised and reissued. It consolidates general DoD transportation and traffic management policies.

4. Responsibilities. Within the Navy, the central points of contact on transportation and traffic management policies are:

a. Office of the Chief of Naval Operations (OPNAV), Director, Supply, Ordnance and Logistics Operations Division, Logistics Operations Programs/Policy Branch (N41/413): transportation policy and management.

b. OPNAV Director, Strategic Mobility and Combat Logistics Division (N42): strategic sealift.

c. Naval Supply Systems Command, Deputy Commander Navy Family Supply Support (SUP05): personal property.

d. Naval Supply Systems Command, Naval Operational Logistics Support Center, Transportation and Distribution Policy, Doctrine and Funding Department, Logistics Doctrine and Policy Division (N433): transportation operations, material movement, traffic management and passenger transportation management.

e. Naval Sea Systems Command, Naval Ordnance Safety and Security Activity, Operations Support Directorate, Ordnance Transportation Manager (N55): ordnance transportation safety and security policy and procedure.



5. Action. Addressees will:

a. Comply with reference (a) in all matters concerning transportation and traffic management.

b. Issue supplementary directives, as required, to implement reference (a).

6. Records Management. Records created as a result of this instruction, shall be managed in accordance with Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1.
