Subj: MANDATORY TRAINING FOR INSPECTORS GENERAL (IG)

Ref: (a) SECNAVINST 5430.57F
(b) NAVINSGEN Investigations Manual

1. Purpose. To establish the requirement that all IGs assigned to Echelon 2 commands attend the Naval Inspector General (NAVINSGEN) IG School within 6 months of reporting as the IG.

2. Discussion

a. In accordance with reference (a), all Echelon 2 IG organizations are assigned additional duty to NAVINSGEN.

b. Reference (b) sets forth guidelines for the conduct of investigations by the Department of the Navy IG personnel and others who may be tasked to conduct IG investigations.

c. The primary purpose of the NAVINSGEN IG School is to train Inspectors General and their staffs on IG operations, with particular emphasis on the conduct of investigations in accordance with reference (b). Practical applications, including case studies, and lessons learned from recent investigations are included in the course materials.

d. Classes will be held at the Washington Navy Yard, 901 M Street, SE, Washington D.C., in Building 200. Classes are scheduled from 0800-1600 daily. There is no charge for attendance.

4. Action

a. NAVINSGEN will publish a schedule annually by letter or message for the NAVINSGEN IG School and provide quota control.

b. All Echelon 2 commands are required to ensure that individuals assigned or designated as the Inspector General for their command are scheduled to attend the NAVINSGEN IG School within 6 months of assignment.
