Subj: RENAME AND MODIFY MISSION OF NAVY MEDICINE SUPPORT
COMMAND, SAN ANTONIO, TX

1. Purpose. To approve renaming and mission modification for shore activity Navy Medicine Support Command (NAVMEDSUPPCOM) per reference (a).

2. Background. This notice modifies the name and mission of NAVMEDSUPPCOM to emphasize its expanded role as the primary echelon 3 medical command responsible for oversight of Navy medicine education and training programs. Mission is modified in response to the increased education and training responsibilities.

3. Organizational Changes. Rename NAVMEDSUPPCOM, San Antonio, TX, and modify mission effective immediately. The following applies:

b. Modified Mission. To exercise command and control over Navy medicine education and training commands; to oversee and carry out the necessary courses of action to ensure the economical and effective delivery of Navy medicine enterprise-wide education and training as directive by Chief, Bureau of Medicine and Surgery; and to exercise program executive office oversight of Navy medicine training programs.


4. Action

a. Chief, Bureau of Medicine and Surgery will take appropriate action to rename subject shore activity and modify mission.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will revise the PLA in the Central Directory Component effective immediately, unless otherwise directed via official correspondence. Correspondence concerning the PLA should be forwarded to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (NAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), Bldg. 1265, Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek Ft Story, Virginia Beach, VA 23459-5000 or by calling (757) 322-1149/1150. NAVNETWARCOM will coordinate revision of the PLA in the Navy Regional Enterprise Message System (NREMS) with applicable Navy Computer and Telecommunications Area Master Station.

c. Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33), will revise reference (b).

5. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
