Subj: MODIFY MISSIONS FOR NAVAL SPECIAL WARFARE GROUPS ONE,
TWO, AND THREE AND NAVAL SPECIAL WARFARE CENTER,
CORONADO, CA

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A

1. Purpose. To approve mission modifications for Naval Special Warfare Groups (NAVSPECWARGRU) ONE, TWO and THREE and Naval Special Warfare Center (NAVSPECWARCEN), per reference (a).

2. Background. These mission modifications are designed to focus each NAVSPECWARGRU on a designed area of operations, and to remove collateral duties from the NAVSPECWARCEN mission and focus it directly on training in naval special warfare (NAVSPECWAR) tactics, techniques, procedures and equipment.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, modify the missions for NAVSPECWARGRUs ONE, TWO and THREE and NAVSPECWARCEN, Coronado, CA. The following applies:

a. NAVSPECWARGRU ONE mission: To organize, man, train, equip, deploy, and sustain NAVSPECWAR forces to conduct full spectrum special operations in support of combatant commanders with focus on U.S. Central Command and U.S. Pacific Command areas of operations.

b. NAVSPECWARGRU TWO mission: To organize, man, train, equip, deploy, and sustain NAVSPECWAR forces to conduct full spectrum special operations in support of combatant commanders with focus on U.S. Africa Command; U.S. European Command, U.S. Northern Command; and U.S. Southern Command areas of operation.

c. NAVSPECWARGRU THREE mission: To organize, man, train, equip, deploy, sustain, and command and control NAVSPECWAR forces to conduct full spectrum undersea special operations and activities worldwide in support of combatant commanders and United States national interests.

d. Naval Special Warfare Center mission: To conduct special operations training and educate United States, foreign armed forces, and other designated personnel in NAVSPECWAR tactics, techniques, procedures and equipment.

4. Action

a. Commander, Naval Special Warfare Command will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to modify the mission statements of each of subject commands.

b. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will insure that a copy of the modified command mission is placed in the master file of each of these commands.

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
