Subj: MODIFY IMMEDIATE SUPERIOR IN COMMAND FOR U.S. SHIP
MAHAN AND U.S. SHIP FARRAGUT

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To approve the modification of immediate superior in command for United States Ship (USS) Mahan and USS Farragut, per reference (a).

2. Background. This action realigns the administrative reporting relationship of the guided-missile destroyer (DDG) USS Mahan from Commander, Destroyer Squadron Two to Commander, Destroyer Squadron Two Two. USS Farragut will shift administrative control from Commander, Destroyer Squadron One Four to Commander, Destroyer Squadron Two. This action follows the U.S. Navy optimized fleet response plan. There are no changes to current manpower, funding, or location involved with the modification. All commands involved remain under the command of Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command.

3. Organizational Changes. Modify reporting relationship for USS Mahan and USS Farragut effective immediately. The following applies:

- 5 Commanding Officer, USS Farragut (DDG 99) (23150)


4. Action

a. Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command shall take appropriate action to effect the modification of reporting relationships for the DDGs.

b. This is advance change 04-15 to reference (b), the standard navy distribution list.

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, shall be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
