Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF U.S. NAVAL SUPPORT FACILITY, REDZIKOWO,  
POLAND

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy approval to establish U.S. Naval Support Facility (NAVSUPPFAC) Redzikowo, Redzikowo, Poland, per reference (a)

2. Background. This action establishes U.S. NAVSUPPFAC Redzikowo per the U.S. and Poland Ballistic Missile Defense Agreement signed in August 2008. The facility will support the U.S. Aegis Ashore Missile Defense System Poland currently under establishment. Host nation notification is not required for this action as it was publically announced by the two governments in 2008.

3. Organizational Changes. Establish U.S. NAVSUPPFAC Redzikowo effective 1 October 2016. The following applies:

b. Mission. To provide efficient and effective shore service support to U.S. and allied forces operating in the NAVSUPPFAC Redzikowo area of responsibility.

c. Office of the Chief of Naval Operations Resource Sponsor. Deputy Chief of Naval Operations Fleet Readiness and Logistics (N4).

d. Area Coordination. Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC).

e. Regional Coordination. Commander, Navy Region Europe Africa Southwest Asia.

f. Budget Submitting Office. Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC).

g. Chain of Command

- 1 Chief of Naval Operations
- 2 Commander, Navy Installations Command
- 3 Commander, Navy Region Europe Africa Southwest Asia (3049B)
- 4 Commanding Officer, U.S. Naval Support Facility Redzikowo (62592)

4. Action

a. CNIC will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to establish U.S. NAVSUPPFAC Radzikowo, Radzikowo, Poland and to issue a mission, functions and tasks directive for the new shore activity within 90 days of such establishment. Distribution of the directive will include Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33).

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will add the PLA in the Central Directory Component and establish NAVSUPPFAC Radzikowo PLA via messaging systems effective immediately upon Navy Region Europe Africa Southwest Asia, new command's immediate superior in command (ISIC), request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), Bldg 1265, Joint Expeditionary Base Little Creek Fort Story, Virginia Beach, VA 23459-5000 via email at [C2OIX\\_Reg@navy.mil](mailto:C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil) or by calling (757) 322-1149/1150. New command will be activated via messaging systems. Additional information on naval messaging can be obtained at



c. DNS-33 will revise reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, shall be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
