Subj: DISESTABLISHMENT OF CENTER FOR PERSONAL AND PROFESSIONAL
DEVELOPMENT, DAM NECK, VIRGINIA BEACH, VA

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy (SECNAV) approval of the disestablishment of Center for Personal and Professional Development (CENPERSPRODEV), Dam Neck, Virginia Beach, VA, per reference (a).
2. Background. This disestablishment results from the need of Commander, Naval Education and Training Command (CNETC) to reduce overhead in order to free funding and resources in support of the Sailor of 2025 initiatives. Critical training capabilities at CENPERSPRODEV will be retained and realigned within other NETC training centers to continue to serve the fleet customers.
3. Organizational Changes. Effective 30 September 2015, disestablish CENPERSPRODEV, Dam Neck, Virginia Beach, VA. The following applies:

4. Action


a. CNETC will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to disestablish CENPERSPRODEV and realign critical trainings capabilities within NETC.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete the PLA in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon CNETC request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. PLA will be deactivated via messaging systems. Additional information on naval messaging can be obtained at <https://sailor.nmci.navy.smil.mil> or by contacting COMNAVNETWARCOM at numbers above. (New direction - CNETC ACTION REQUIRED regarding the PLA).

c. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will delete command from reference (b) effective 30 September 2015.

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, shall be managed per SECNAV Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
