Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF NAVAL RESERVE OFFICERS TRAINING CORPS
UNIT MARYLAND CONSORTIUM, COLLEGE PARK AND BALTIMORE
COUNTY, MD

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy (SECNAV) approval to establish Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps Unit (NROTCU) Maryland Consortium, College Park and Baltimore County, MD, per reference (a).

2. Background. Establishment of the new NROTCU consortium is being undertaken in order to increase the number of NROTCUs at major universities requesting units and as directed by Chief of Naval Operations. The Chief of Naval Personnel (CHNAVPERS) will provide funding support for the new unit staff at both locations, but there will be only one commanding officer at College Park, MD.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective 1 October 2015, establish NROTCU Maryland Consortium. The following applies:

b. Mission. To develop midshipmen morally, mentally, and physically and to imbue them with the highest ideals of duty, and loyalty and with core values of honor, courage, and commitment in order to commission college graduates as naval officers who possess a basic professional background, are motivated toward careers in the naval service, and have a potential for future development in mind and character so as to assume the highest responsibilities of command, citizenship, and government.

c. Budget Submitting Office. CHNAVPERS.

d. Office of the Chief of Naval Operations Resource Sponsor. Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Manpower, Personnel Training and Education (CNO N1).

e. Area Coordination. Commander, Navy Installations Command.

f. Regional Coordination. Commander, Navy Region Mid-Atlantic.

g. Chain of Command

4. Action

a. Commander, Naval Education and Training Command (CNETC) will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to establish subject shore activity.


b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will add the PLA in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon CNETC request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at

C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil, or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. New PLA will be activated via messaging systems. Additional information on naval messaging can be obtained at <https://sailor.nmci.navy.mil> or by contacting COMNAVNETWARCOM at numbers above. (New direction - CNETC ACTION REQUIRED regarding the PLA).

c. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will add the new command to reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per SECNAV Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
