Subj: RENAME NAVAL SURFACE WARFARE CENTER INDIAN HEAD EXPLOSIVE  
ORDNANCE DISPOSAL TECHNOLOGY DIVISION TECHNICAL SUPPORT  
DETACHMENT AND MODIFY MISSION

(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To approve renaming and mission modification for Naval Surface Warfare Center Indian Head Explosive Ordnance Disposal Technology Division Technical Support Detachment (NAVSURFWARCENIHEODTECHDIV TECHSUPPDET), per reference (a).

2. Background. This action will change the detachment name to align it with standard U.S. Navy explosive ordnance disposal naming conventions, as the current ambiguous name does not provide insight to outside organizations or personnel as to the nature of the detachment's mission. The renaming of the detachment and modification of its mission are planned as the first steps in its eventual standup as a separate command.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, rename NAVSURFWARCENIHEODTECHDIV TECSUPPDET. The following applies:

b. Revised Mission. To collect, process, exploit, and analyze improvised weapons, to include improvised explosive devices and conventional ordnance, for the purpose of providing time sensitive technical intelligence to tactical and operational commanders and explosive ordnance disposal forces, and to provide tailored deployable exploitation and acquisition support to Department of Defense, all Military Services, and national level intelligence activities.

#### 4. Action

a. Commander, Naval Sea Systems Command (COMNAVSEASYSCOM) will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to rename and modify the mission of subject shore detachment.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will revise the PLA in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon COMNAVSEASYSCOM request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at [C2OIX\\_Reg@navy.mil](mailto:C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil) or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. Revised PLA will be activated via messaging systems. c. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will revise reference (b) per organization actions directed in this notice.

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.
