Subj: ESTABLISH PERMANENT DUTY STATION FOR MOBILE LANDING
PLATFORM FOUR AFLOAT FORWARD STAGING BASE MILITARY
DETACHMENT

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To establish Mobile Landing Platform FOUR Afloat Forward Staging Base Military Detachment (MLP-4 AFSB MILDET) and the permanent duty station (PDS) for the MILDET, per reference (a).

2. Background. The hull for MLP-4 AFSB is being constructed by General Dynamics NASSCO San Diego, CA. Due to the uniqueness of the mission for MLPs, MLP-4 AFSB will be manned by a hybrid crew of civilian mariners and a permanent military detachment. The PDS for the associated MILDET must be stood up in Norfolk, VA.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, establish PDS for MLP-4 AFSB MILDET. The following applies:

b. Mission. The MPL-4 AFSB supports airborne mine countermeasure and special operations force missions. MLP-4 AFSB will be manned by a hybrid crew of civilian mariners and a permanent military crew in support of a large, stable platform with a flight deck, boat operations, embarked force berthing, mission planning and execution, and command and control capabilities.

c. Budget Submitting Office. Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command (00060).

d. Office of the Chief of Naval Operations Resource Sponsor. Director, Expeditionary Warfare Division (OPNAV N95).

e. Area Coordination. Commander, Navy Installations Command (00052).

f. Regional Coordination. Commander, Navy Region Mid Atlantic (61463).

g. Administrative Chain of Command

4. Action

a. Commander, Naval Surface Forces Atlantic (COMNAVSURFLANT) must take appropriate action to establish MLP-4 AFSB MILDET and the permanent duty station for the MILDET. Ensure MLP-4 AFSB MILDET is properly manned, fully trained, capably equipped, and well maintained.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will revise the PLAs in the central directory component via messaging systems effective immediately upon COMNAVSURFLANT request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM SUFFOLK VA) (Attn: Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. 

c. This is advance change 28-15 to reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
