UNIT YALE UNIVERSITY, NEW HAVEN, CT AND RENAME NAVAL
RESERVE OFFICERS TRAINING CORPS UNIT HOLY CROSS YALE
CONSORTIUM, WORCESTER, MA

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy (SECNAV) approval to establish Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps Unit (NROTCU) Yale University and to rename NROTCU Holy Cross Yale Consortium, per reference (a).

2. Background. The proposed establishment results from the tremendous growth in the NROTCU class at Yale University, which is currently part of the NROTCU Holy Cross Yale Consortium. Each school will now have its own separate NROTCU and College of the Holy Cross will return to its former NROTCU name.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, establish NROTCU Yale University and rename NROTCU at College of the Holy Cross. The following applies:

4. Action


a. Commander, Naval Education and Training Command (NETC) will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to establish and rename subject shore activities.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will add and revise the PLAs in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon NETC request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. New and revised PLAs will be activated via messaging systems. c. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will add the Yale command and revise the Holy Cross command in reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per SECNAV Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
