Subj: RENAME and RELOCATE HELICOPTER ANTISUBMARINE SQUADRON
ELEVEN

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To modify the name and location of Helicopter Antisubmarine Squadron ELEVEN (HS-11), per reference (a).

2. Background. The renaming of HS-11 to Helicopter Sea Combat Squadron ELEVEN (HSC-11) will reflect the new community designation and the transition from the Sikorsky Antisubmarine Warfare Helicopter (SH-60F) and Sikorsky Search and Rescue Helicopter (HH-60H), due to end of service life, to the Sikorsky Multi-Mission Helicopter (MH-60S). With the transition of aircraft, the squadron will also execute a permanent duty station change from Naval Air Station Jacksonville in Jacksonville, FL to Naval Station Norfolk. This change is in support of naval aviation helicopter concept of operations and the Commander, Naval Air Force (COMNAVAIRFOR) Master Air Plan 13-02. HSC-11 will remain an active duty operational squadron.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective 1 June 2016, rename and relocate HS-11. The following applies:

b. Mission. Operate and support an eight-plane MH-60S HSC squadron on aircraft carriers. Be prepared to simultaneously operate on the aircraft carrier and provide one two-plane detachment to carrier strike group based supply ship. Additionally, be capable of providing a one-plane or a two-plane detachment to air capable ships or land bases. The detachment shall be personnel recovery and special operation forces capable, but not concurrently. Projected deployment cycle is per the current optimized fleet response plan.

4. Action


a. Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command and COMNAVAIRFOR shall take appropriate action to direct and coordinate the renaming and relocating of HS-11 to HSC-11. Ensure HSC-11 is deployable, properly manned, fully trained, capably equipped, interoperable, well maintained, and combat-sustainable as an operational squadron to meet the mission requirements, the required operational capabilities, and projected operational environment for carrier based MH-60S squadrons.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will revise the PLAs in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective 1 June 2016, following COMNAVAIRFOR request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM SUFFOLK VA) (Attn: Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696; via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil, or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. Per request, PLAs will be activated, deleted, or modified via messaging systems. Additional information regarding naval messaging can be obtained at <https://sailor.nmci.navy.smil.mil> or by contacting COMNAVNETWARCOM at numbers above. (New direction - COMNAVAIRFOR ACTION REQUIRED regarding the PLA.)

c. This is advance change 31-15 to reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, shall be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
