Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF OFFICE OF NAVAL RESEARCH GLOBAL, SAO PAULO, BRAZIL AND RELOCATION OF OFFICE OF NAVAL RESEARCH GLOBAL HEADQUARTERS FROM SINGAPORE TO LONDON, ENGLAND

(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy (SECNAV) approval to establish Office of Naval Research Global, Sao Paulo, Brazil and to approve the relocation of Office of Naval Research Global (ONRG) headquarters from Singapore to London, England, per reference (a).

2. Background. The proposed establishment results from the significant growth in the science and technology and research and development areas in Brazil which has led to increased collaboration between ONRG and Brazilian universities. Relations currently handled out of the ONRG office in Chile will be enhanced by establishment of the new office in Sao Paulo. The relocation of the ONRG headquarters to the ONRG office in London results from the executive officer in London fleeting up to the commanding officer position.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, establish ONRG Office Sao Paulo and relocate ONRG headquarters to London. The following applies:

To seek opportunities to promote science and technology collaboration of mutual benefit between the United States and researchers around the globe; to increase the U.S. Navy awareness of global emerging technology; and to perform such other functions and tasks as may be directed by higher authority.

(3) Budget Submitting Office. Chief of Naval Research (CNR)

(4) Office of the Chief of Naval Operations Resource Sponsor. Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Integration of Capabilities and Resources (CNO N8).

4. Action


a. CNR will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to establish and relocate subject shore activities, and to issue a mission, functions, and task directive for the new shore activity within 90 days of such establishment. Distribution of this directive will include Director, Navy Staff (DNS-33).

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will add and revise the PLAs in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon ONRG request to Naval Network Warfare Command (NAVNETWARCOM) (Attn: NETOPS 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. Per request, new and revised PLAs will be activated via messaging systems. c. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will add the ONRG Sao Paulo command and revise the ONRG headquarters listing in reference (b).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per SECNAV Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
