Subj: MISSION MODIFICATION FOR NAVY EXPEDITIONARY COMBAT
COMMAND, VIRGINIA BEACH, VA

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A

1. Purpose. To approve mission modification for Navy Expeditionary Combat Command (NAVEXPDCMBTCOM), per reference (a).
2. Background. The mission statement for NAVEXPDCMBTCOM is being modified to better reflect the wide range of responsibilities assigned to the command. There is no change to command location, manpower assigned or financial information.
3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, modify NAVEXPFCMBTCOM mission as follows: To organize, man, train, equip and sustain Navy Expeditionary Combat Forces (NECF) to execute combat, combat support, and combat service support missions across the full spectrum of naval, joint, and combined operations which enable access from the sea and freedom of action throughout the sea-to-shore and inland operating environments; to provide a deployable flag officer-led Navy expeditionary warfare commander battle staff to command and control expeditionary forces in support of combatant commander theater plans, as Commander, Task Force 86 for Defense Support of Civil Affairs operations, and as Commander, Task Group 80.10 for the training and oversight of assigned NECFs; and to serve as the designated primary executive agent for mobilization and enduring individual augmentee (IA) support throughout the IA continuum, while providing Navy personnel to augment Joint and Navy forces in support of contingency operations, full scale war, or other national emergencies.

4. Action. Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to issue a revised mission, functions, and tasks directive for NAVEXPDCMBTCOM within 90 days. Distribution of that directive will include Director, Navy Staff, Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33).

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
