Subj: MODIFY ADMINISTRATIVE ASSIGNMENT FOR FLEET WEATHER CENTERS SAN DIEGO, CA AND NORFOLK, VA, NAVAL ICE CENTER SUITLAND, MD, JOINT TYPHOON WARNING CENTER, PEARL HARBOR, HI AND RENAME AND REALIGN FLEET WEATHER CENTER SAN DIEGO AVIATION DETACHMENT PEARL HARBOR

1. Purpose. To approve administrative realignment of Fleet Weather Centers (FLTWEACEN) San Diego, CA and Norfolk, VA, Naval Ice Center (NAVICECEN) Suitland, MD, Joint Typhoon Warning Center (JOINT TYPHOON WARCEN) Pearl Harbor, HI, and rename and realign FLTWEACEN San Diego Aviation Detachment (Det) Pearl Harbor, per reference (a).

2. Background. Commander, Navy Information Dominance Forces (COMNAVIDFOR) requires a realignment of subordinate commands to effectively accomplish operational meteorology and oceanography mission to facilitate operational tasking or reporting and proper fleet alignment. Immediate superior in command relationships remain unchanged.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, modify activities administrative chain of command and det name as follows:

4. Action
