Subj: DISESTABLISHMENT OF NAVAL COMPUTER AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS
STATION, JACKSONVILLE, FL AND DETACHMENT KEY WEST, FL,
AND ESTABLISHMENT OF NAVAL COMPUTER AND
TELECOMMUNICATIONS STATION HAMPTON ROADS, NORFOLK, VA

1. Purpose. To implement Secretary of the Navy (SECNAV) approval of the disestablishment of U.S. Naval Computer and Telecommunications Station (NAVCOMTELSTA) Jacksonville, FL and the establishment of NAVCOMTELSTA Hampton Roads, Norfolk, VA, and Chief of Naval Operations approval of the disestablishment of NAVCOMTELSTA Jacksonville Detachment Key West, FL, per reference (a).

2. Background. The NAVCOMTELSTA at Jacksonville has lost mission areas of responsibility and will be reduced to a detachment of the Naval Computer and Telecommunications Area Master Station Atlantic (NCTAMS LANT). Its small detachment at Key West, FL is no longer required and will be closed, with one enlisted and two civilian personnel transferred to NCTAMS LANT in Norfolk, VA. The NCTAMS LANT detachment in Hampton Roads has experienced significant growth in both manpower and missions areas which requires command leadership and structure and is being upgraded to command status as NAVCOMTELSTA Hampton Roads.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, make the following organizational changes:

4. Action

a. Commander, U.S. Fleet Cyber Command and COMUSFLTFORCOM will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to disestablish and establish subject shore activities and detachments, and to issue a mission, functions, and tasks directive for the new shore activity within 90 days of such establishment. Distribution of this directive will include Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33).

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete and revise the PLAs in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon Commanding Officer, NCTAMS LANT request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. Per request, PLAs will be deleted or modified via messaging systems. (New direction - NCTAMS LANT ACTION REQUIRED regarding the PLA).

c. DNS-33 will revise reference (b) as appropriate.

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per SECNAV Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
