Subj: ESTABLISHMENT OF NAVAL SPECIAL WARFARE UNIT FOUR,
HOMESTEAD, FL

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To approve establishment of Naval Special Warfare Unit (NAVSPECWARUNIT) Four, Homestead, FL, per reference (a).

2. Background. NAVSPECWARUNIT Four previously existed at Roosevelt Roads, PR, but was disestablished as a command and reduced to a Naval Special Warfare Command established component in Norfolk, VA in 2003. Now, to satisfy increased naval special warfare mission requirements in the U.S. Southern Command area of responsibilities (AOR), it is being re-established at Homestead Air Reserve Base in Homestead, FL.

3. Organizational Changes. Effective immediately, establish NAVSPECWARUNT Four at Homestead, FL. The following applies:

b. Mission. To conduct theater reception and logistics support for naval special warfare forces, to plan and coordinate special operations, and to command and control special operations forces in the U.S. Southern Command AOR, when directed.

c. Budget Submitting Office. Naval Special Warfare Command (NAVSPECWARCOM) and Special Operations Command.

d. Office of the Chief of Naval Operations (OPNAV) Resource Sponsor. Director, Expeditionary Warfare (OPNAV N95).

e. Area Coordination. Commander, Naval Installations Command.

f. Regional Coordination. Commander, Navy Region Southeast.

g. Administrative Chain of Command

- 3 Commander, Naval Special Warfare Group Two (0031A)
- 4 Commanding Officer, Naval Special Warfare Unit Four (36024)

4. Action

a. NAVSPECWARCOM will take appropriate action, consistent with reference (a), to establish NAVSPECWARUNIT Four.

b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will add the PLA in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon NAVSPECWARUNIT FOUR request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. New PLA will be activated via messaging systems. Additional information on naval messaging can be obtained at <https://sailor.nmci.navy.smil.mil> or by contacting COMNAVNETWARCOM at numbers above. (New direction - NAVSPECWARUNIT FOUR ACTION REQUIRED regarding the PLA).

c. Director, Navy Staff Organization and Management Branch (DNS-33) will add the new command to reference (b) immediately. This is advanced change 41-15.

5. Records Management. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of media or format, must be managed per Secretary of the Navy Manual 5210.1 of January 2012.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for 1 year or until superseded, whichever occurs first. The organization action will remain effective until changed by Director, Navy Staff.
