Subj: CHANGE IN PERMANENT DUTY STATION FOR MOBILE TACTICAL OPERATIONS CENTER SIX AND DISESTABLISHMENT OF COMMANDER, PATROL AND RECONNAISSANCE WING ONE DETACHMENT MISAWA

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 5400.44A
(b) OPNAVINST 5400.45

1. Purpose. To approve the relocation of Mobile Tactical Operations Center Six (MTOC SIX) from Naval Air Facility (NAF) Misawa, Japan to Naval Air Station (NAS) Whidbey Island, WA and the disestablishment of Commander, Patrol and Reconnaissance Wing One Detachment Misawa (COMPATRECONWING ONE DET MISAWA), per reference (a).

2. Background. Per TACMOBILE Program of Record, Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet (COMPACFLT), Commander, Naval Air Force U.S. Pacific Fleet (COMNAVAIRPAC), and Commander, Patrol and Reconnaissance Group Pacific (COMPATRECONGRUPAC) must oversee and execute the TACMOBILE transition plan for tactical operation center (TOC) and mobile tactical operations center (MTOC).

a. MTOC SIX and COMPATRECONWING ONE DET MISAWA provide TACMOBILE support (command, control, computers, communications, intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance) to patrol squadrons (VP) that deploy to Japan. MTOC SIX provides support at expeditionary airfields and COMPATRECONWING ONE DET MISAWA provides support at the tactical support center in Misawa.

b. MTOC SIX must shift to NAS Whidbey Island and join MTOCs 2, 4, 8, 10, and 12 in direct support of Pacific Fleet VPs' transition from P-3C aircraft to P-8A aircraft during the fiscal years (FY) 17-19 timeframe per Navy Master Aviation Plan 15-1.

c. COMPATRECONWING ONE DET MISAWA must disestablish as its equipment set reaches end of service life (October 2015). TACMOBILE support for VPs deployed to Japan has been realigned to TOC Kadena.

4. Action

a. COMPACFLT, COMNAVAIRPAC, and COMPATRECONGRUPAC must take appropriate action to relocate MTOC SIX from NAF Misawa to NAS Whidbey Island, modify MTOCs in direct support of VP squadron transition from P-3C aircraft to P-8A aircraft, and rotationally deploy MTOCs with P-8A squadron deployments. Ensure MTOC SIX is organized, properly manned, fully trained, well maintained, capably equipped, and interoperable to meet the mission requirements per required operational capability and projected operational environment for TOC and MTOC in OPNAVINST C3501.376A.

b. COMPACFLT, COMNAVAIRPAC, and COMPATRECONGRUPAC must take appropriate action to disestablish COMPATRECONWING ONE DET MISAWA due to equipment reaching end of service life. Detachment billets must be re-assigned within maritime patrol and reconnaissance force community, primarily as compensation to pay back VP-30 Fleet Replacement Squadron and Maritime Patrol and Reconnaissance Weapons School for providing billets to standup MTOCs 8, 10, and 12 at NAS Whidbey Island.

c. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will delete the PLA in the Central Directory Component via messaging systems effective immediately upon COMPATRECONWING ONE DET MISAWA request to Commander, Naval Network Warfare Command (COMNAVNETWARCOM) (Network Operations 321), 112 Lake View Pkwy, Suffolk, VA 23435-2696, via email at C2OIX_Reg@navy.mil or by calling (757) 203-0338/0339. COMPATRECONWING ONE DET MISAWA must request the PLA be disestablished for its detachment at the tactical support center in Misawa Japan. d. This is advance change 10-15 to reference (b).
